Castel del Monte was built between 1240 and 1250 by the Emperor Federico II on the hill of Andria, in the south of Italy.

It has an octagonal structure and it was used as hunting lodge and astronomical observatory.

In the Castle, there are four empty rooms and the external side is built in limestone and marble.

Castel del Monte is depicted on the one-cent coin and it is UNESCO heritage.
