Mole Antonelliana is a building situated in the historical centre of Turin. The name derives from the fact that in the past it was the highest masonry construction of Europe, while the adjective comes from the architect Alessandro Antonelli. The Mole with the 168 meter height, for years was the tallest building in Turin. Today the monument houses the National Cinema Museum. The Mole Antonelliana is depicted on the two-cent coin.
